





Wall Track Brackets

Read these instructions carefully and follow all steps in sequence.














6" and 12" suspension or fixed Arms



16" suspension or lift Arms




Extender Arms






ERGONOMIC MOUNTING HEIGHT RECOMMENDATIONS

Before proceeding with installation, plan carefully. Read through all steps first, and familiarize yourself with the ergonomic guidelines covered in Ergotron's Installation Planning Guide (888-99-012) or for Flat Panel Monitor Arms, the Ergonomic Data and Mounting Heights Guide (888-99-014) that was shipped with your Ergotron Mounting Solution.



DETERMINE MOUNTING HEIGHT

2a. Determine mounting height based on the Ergonomic Mounting Height Recommendations on page 2 and put a pencil mark where the bottom of the mounting bracket should be.

STEP

ATTACH MOUNTING SOLUTION TO WALL TRACK

NOTE: This manual covers two different mounting methods.


Option 1: Slide mounting solution into wall track from the top. **Option 2:** Slide mounting solution into wall track from the bottom.

Follow the set of instructions that is appropriate for you.

Option 1: Slide mounting solution into wall track from the top

3a. Slide Stop Block into wall track, position just below pencil mark and secure with the provided 1/8" hex wrench and Set screw.

3b. Slide Wall Track Brackets and mounting solution into wall track and position with bottom of Brackets at pencil mark.




Option 2: Slide mounting solution into wall track from the bottom

3a. Slide mounting solution up into wall track and position with bottom of mounting bracket at pencil mark.


3b. Slide Stop Block up into wall track and position just below pencil mark.




SECURE MOUNTING SOLUTION TO WALL TRACK

4a. With a 9/16" wrench, tighten the hex screws to secure the mounting solution to the wall track.

4b. With the 1/8" hex wrench and set screw, secure the Stop Block to the wall track.





Warranty
